



Start at **Step 2** for deep water braces without the addition of chain retainers.

Start at **Step 3** for deep water braces used with chain retainers.




DEEP WATER LEG BRACE INSTRUCTIONS 4X8 DOCK / 8x8 DOCK



Install brace to the inside of the dock leg (See image above). Place overtop of the existing locknut and fasten with a new lock nut (NL38). Follow **Step 2** for any additional braces.

PLEASE NOTE: Only hand tighten locknuts so the brace may move freely for **Step 5**. If you are adding retainers to your dock continue to **Step 3**, if you are not, continue to **Step 4**.




* Chain Retainer (CR1) is sold separately





DEEP WATER LEG BRACE INSTRUCTIONS 4X8 DOCK / 8x8 DOCK

Place top hole of brace onto the hole of the chain retainer (See image above).






Fasten brace with carriage bolt and locknut. **PLEASE NOTE:** Only hand tighten the nuts so the brace moves freely for **Step 5**.

Brace top complete. Repeat **Steps 3 A-E** for any additional braces and continue to **Step 4**.

* If you purchased the 4x8 dock kit the **DWBR63** brace will be used. If you purchased the 8x8 dock kit the **DWBR120** brace will be used.




Fasten both jaws (DWSB1 & DWSB2) together on the leg. Repeat **Step 3** for other legs that any installed braces will be connected to.




DEEP WATER LEG BRACE INSTRUCTIONS 4X8 DOCK / 8x8 DOCK





With the brace connected at one end place the opposite end between the two slots located on the edge of the jaw assembly (See image above).



Fasten the brace end with a carriage bolt(CB15S) and locknut(NL38). Tighten both ends of the brace. Repeat Steps from the beginning of the instruction to connect the second brace to the dock.
