



Narrow Mouth (SHN1)






Each pair of hinges will be indentified by a narrow and wide mouth (See above image).

The narrow mouth bracket will fit into the wide bracket of each pair.

Wide Mouth (SHW1)




Connect the hinge assembly as shown above.


















On the opposite dock connect hinge assembly as shown above.

































Once hinges (HP1) on both docks are assembled pull both docks close to each other. Place the docks so the edges of both docks are aligned with one another. Align the hinges on either side of the docks so they fit into each other (See images above). Ensure that the holes between both hinges line up with one another. Do the same for the hinges on the opposite side of both docks.





An optional sleeve(VS1) has been included with your kit to dampen any movement and sound that may arise from hinge use. Slide the vinyl sleeve onto the end of the pin(HP1).



Fasten hinge as shown. Repeat **Step 6** for hinge assembly on the opposite end of the dock. **PLEASE NOTE:** It may be helpful to use locking pliers to insert the cotter pin into the hinge pin.

When separating dock sections follow the above directions in reverse removing the Cotter Pin (CP1) and then removing the Hinge Pin(HP1) from between the hinges.
